The ASE m/v YERSIN 251', external styling by PJ Kubis Designs.

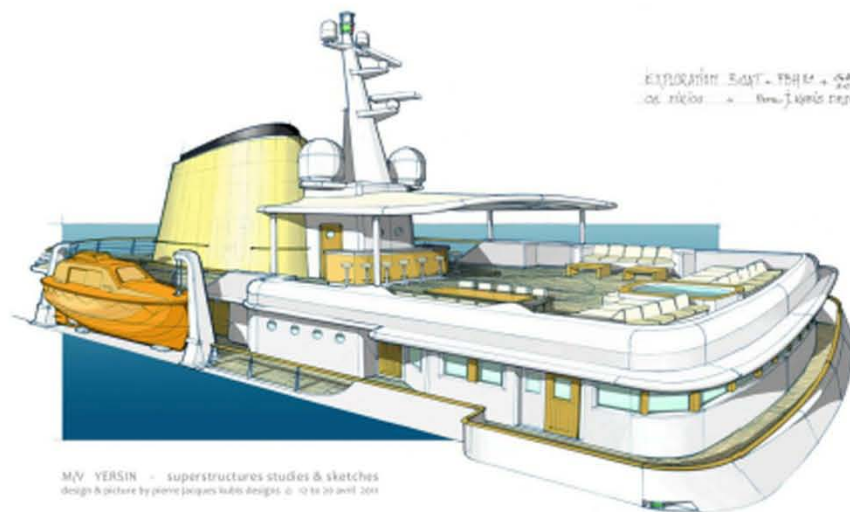


The boat displays a today's unusual exterior lines, inspired by the ships of the beginning of the 20 th century. The yellow funnel and hydro-plane complete the nearly vertical bow, tensed waters entries, a small bulb on a bronze grey hull, topped by flow and sober superstructures shape with her Portuguese bridge to make an identifiable and assumed exploration vessel.

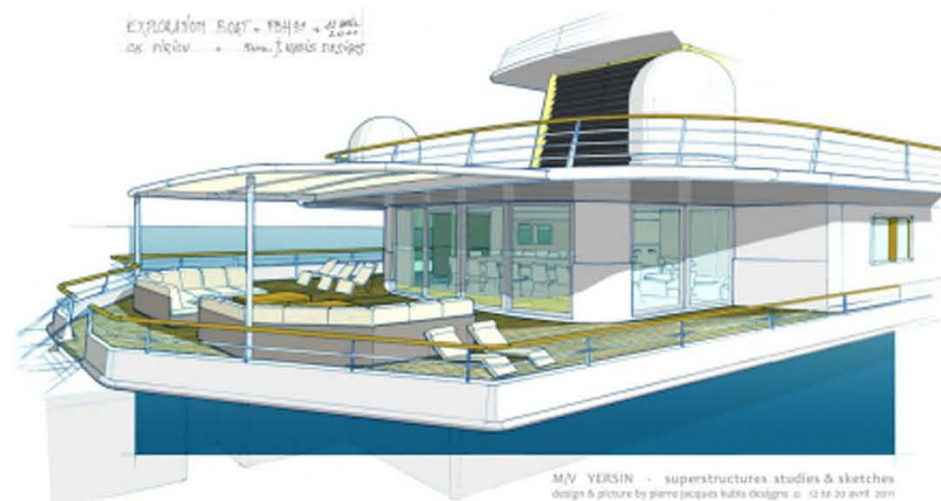

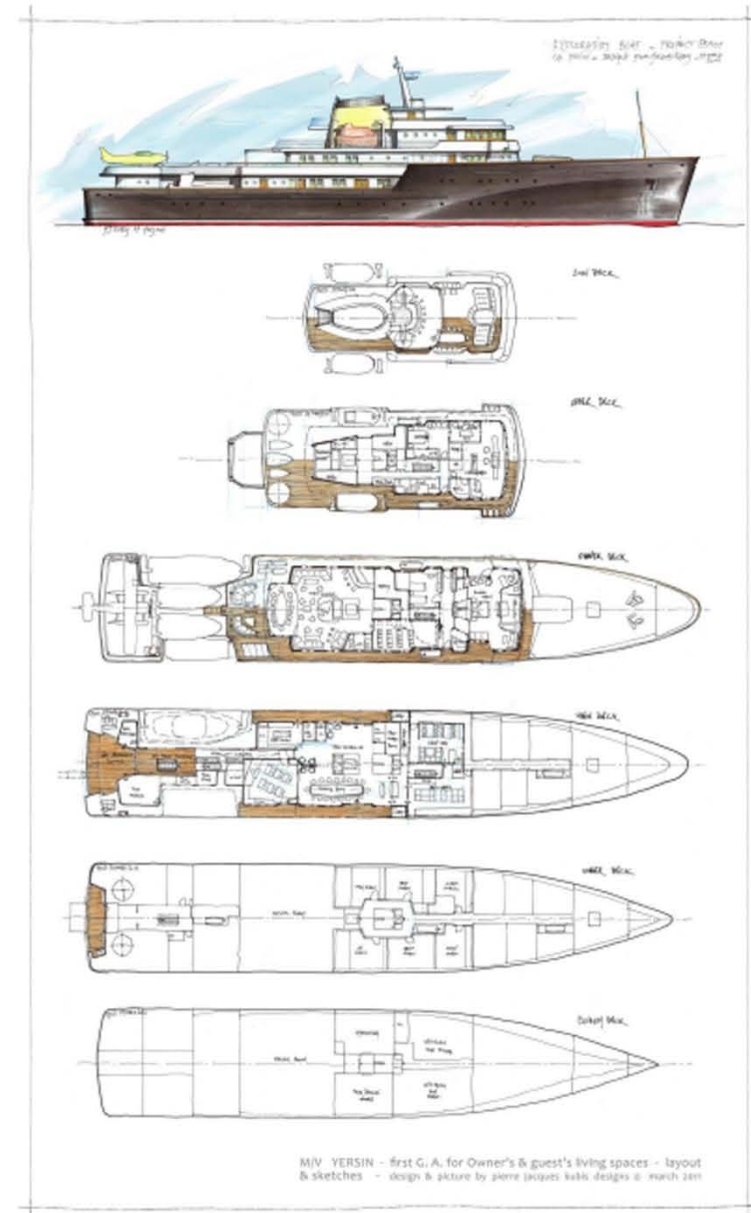

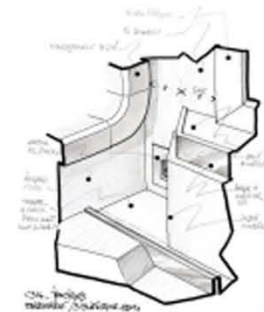
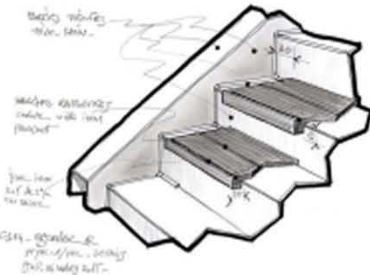
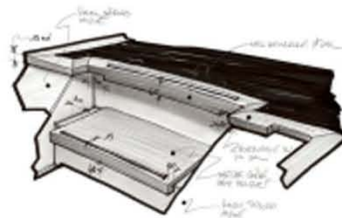
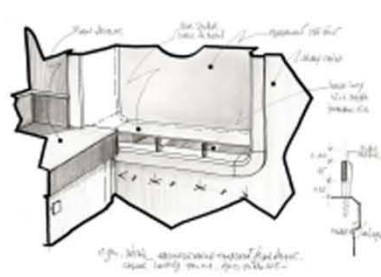
